'David Copperfield' by Charles Dickens

David was born half-orphan, as his father died before his birth. His mother re-marries, but new family does not bring happiness for David. Few more characters are vital for the plot, but ... you need to find it out yourself!

David Copperfield was first published in instalments in 1849-1850, full version followed in 1858.

'Oliver Twist' by Charles Dickens

The plot of the novel is set in a provincial town in England, and later in London and other places. The main Character, Oliver Twist, is an orphan who was placed in a child workhouse. He is expelled, and has a stint at the undertakers business, but due to human malice he has to run. He arrives in London and the story gains momentum, but ... you need to find it out yourself!
